This disk is a single-density TRSDOS data disk with no operating system. Model I users can simply place their operating system in Drive 0 and the LOAD 80 disk in Drive 1. Model III users must first use the TRSDOS CONVERT utility. Users with only one drive must own an operating system or utility which permits single-file, single-drive copying. Model III owners have the added problem of copying from single density to double density.
